### REPORT OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Directors' are pleased to present their report for the Third quarter ended 30 June 2016 together with the un-audited condensed interim financial information of the Company and the Group for the third quarter ended 30 June 2016. The Group results comprises of Archroma Pakistan Limited (ARPL) and Archroma Textiles Chemicals Pakistan (Pvt) Ltd. (ATCPPL) a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company.

### MATERIAL INFORMATION

The Shareholders at Extraordinary General Meeting held on 3rd June 2016 has decided that the Scheme of Arrangement for the amalgamation of Archroma Pakistan Limited and Archroma Textiles Chemicals Pakistan (Pvt.) Limited, all as stated in the Scheme of Arrangement dated 8 March 2016 between ARPL and its Members and ATCPPL and its Members, be and is hereby approved, adopted and agreed. The Scheme shall become operative as on 1 Jan 2016 or as directed by the Court.

### **BUSINESS OVERVIEW**

Archroma teams with a 'can do' and accountable mindset, trying to create 'the delta' - growth compared to last year, and succeeding in it. We enjoying the ride by achieving a top line growth of 6% by the Company, contributed favorable growth in the business line of Paper at 23%, Emulsions at 9% & Textiles at 7%. We are moving and we

are improving every day. We are striving to continue the growth momentum based on our ACTS pillars of our Archroma work culture i.e. ACTS (Accountability for performance, Customer and market focus, Teamwork and collaboration, Speed and simplicity), behaviors and 'cando' mindset.

### 1. THE COMPANY AND ITS OPERATIONS

Archroma Pakistan Limited ("the Company") is a limited liability company and is incorporated and domiciled in Pakistan. The address of its registered office is 1-A/1, Sector 20 Korangi Industrial Area, Korangi, Karachi, Pakistan. The Company is listed on the Pakistan Stock Exchange (formerly: Karachi Stock Exchange). The Company is a subsidiary of Archroma Textiles S.a.r.l incorporated in Luxembourg, head quartered in Reinach, Switzerland which holds 75% of the share capital of the Company.

The Company is engaged in the manufactures and sells chemicals, dyestuffs and emulsions, mainly for textile, paper, paint and construction inductries. It also acts as an indenting agent.

The Company has a wholly owned subsidiary namely Archroma Textiles Chemicals Pakistan (Private) Limited (formerly: BASF Pakistan Private Limited)

### 2. STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

This condensed interim financial information have been prepared in accordance with the approved accounting standards as applicable in Pakistan for interim financial reporting. Approved accounting standards comprise of the International Accounting Standard 34-"Interim Financial Reporting" issued by the International Accounting Standards Board the requirement of the Companies Ordinance 1984 and the directives issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP). Where the requirement of the Companies Ordinance, 1984 and the directives issued by the SECP differ with the requirements of IAS 34, requirements of or directives issued under the Companies Ordinance, 1984 have been followed.

This condensed interim financial information should be read in conjunction with the annual financial statements of the company for the nine months period ended 30 September 2015.

### 3. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

**3.1** The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this condenced interim financial information are consistent with those applied in preparation of the published annual financial information of the Company for the year ended 30 September 2015.

### 4. CRITICAL ACCOUNTING ESTIMATE AND JUDGEMENTS

The preparation of condensed Interim financial statements requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of accounting policies and reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income and expenses. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

In preparing this condensed interim financial information, the significant judgements made by management in applying the Company's accounting policies and the key sources of estimation uncertainty were the same as those that applied to the annual financial statements of the Company for the year ended 30 September 2015.

### 6. SHORT TERM BORROWING - secured

- 6.1 Short term running finance facilities are available from various commercial banks under mark-up arrangements amounting to Rs. 2,400 million (30 september 2015: Rs. 1,800 million). These facilities have various maturity dates upto 31 March 2017. These arrangements are secured against pari passu charge of hypothecation of the Company's stock in trade and trade debts with minimum 16.5% margin. These running finance facilities carry mark-up ranging from 3 months KIBOR+0.3% to 3 months KIBOR+0.8% per annum and is payable on quarterly basis.
- **6.2** The Company has borrowed short term running finance under the Export Refinance Scheme of the State Bank of Pakistan of Pakistan (SBP). The facility available is for an amount of Rs. 435 million (2015: Rs. 435 million). The rate of mark-up on this facility was 4.5% per annum.

### 7. CONTINGENCIES AND COMMITMENTS

### 7.1 Contingencies

- **7.1.1** There have been no changes in the contingencies as disclosed in the annual financial statements of the Company for the year ended 30 September 2015.
- **7.1.2** The Company has provided bank guarantees amounting to Rs. 66.475 million (30 September 2015: Rs 88.532 million) in favour of third parties.
- **7.1.3** The Company has provided post dated cheques amounting to Rs. 114.484 million (30 September 2015:148.88 million) in favour of the collector of customs and which are, in the normal course of business, to be returned to the Company after fulfillment of certain conditions.

### 10. TAXATION

The Finance Act, 2015 introduced a new tax under Section 5A of the Income Tax ordinance, 2001 at the rate of 10 percent on every public company other than a scheduled bank or modaraba, that derives profits for the tax year and does not distribute cash dividend within six months of the end of said tax year or distribute dividend to such an extend that its reserves, after such distribution, are in excess of 100% of its paid up capital, so much of its reserves as exceed hundred percent of its paid up capital be treated as income of said company. However, this tax on undistributed reserves is not applicable to a public company which distributes profit equal to either 40 percent of its after tax profit or 50% of its paid-up capital, whichever is less, within six months of the end of the tax year.

The company intends to distribute sufficient cash dividend for the year ending 30 September 2016 to comply with the above stated requirement. Accordingly, no provision for tax on undistributed reserves has been recognized in these condensed unconsolidated interim financial information.

### 1. THE COMPANY AND ITS OPERATIONS

Archroma Pakistan Limited, (ARPL) ("the Parent Company") is a limited liability company and is incorporated and domiciled in Pakistan. The address of its registered office is 1-A/1, Sector 20 Korangi Industrial Area, Korangi, Karachi, Pakistan. The Parent Company is listed on the Pakistan Stock Exchange (formerly: Karachi Stock Exchange). The Parent Company is a subsidiary of Archroma Textiles S.a.r.l (Ultimate Parent Company), incorporated in Luxembourg, head quartered in Reinach, Switzerland which holds 75% of the share capital of the Company.

The Parent Company is engaged in the manufactures and sells chemicals, dyestuffs and emulsions, mainly for textile, paper, paint and construction industries. It also acts as an indenting agent.

### 1.1 STATUS AND NATURE OF BUSINESS

The Group consists of:

- i) Archroma Pakistan Limited (the 'Parent Company)
- ii) Archroma Textiles Chemicals Pakistan (Private) Limited (the 'Subsidiary')

### 2. STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

This condensed interim consolidated financial information of the Company for the nine months period ended 30 June 2016 have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the International Accounting Standard 34 - "Interim Financial Reporting" and the provision of and directive issued under the Companies Ordinance 1984 . In case where requirement differ the provision of or directive issued under the Companies Ordinance, 1984 have been followed.

This condensed interim consolidated financial information does not include all the information required for full annual financial statements and should be read in conjunction with the annual audited separate financial statements of the company for the year ended 30 September 2015.

The comparative balance sheet presented in this condensed interim consolidated financial information has been extracted from the audited annual separate financial statements of the company for the year ended 30 September 2015, whereas the comparative condensed interim profit and loss account, condensed interim cash flow statement and condensed interim statement of changes in equity are extracted from the unaudited condensed interim financial information for the period ended 30 June 2015.

### 2.1 BASIS OF CONSOLIDATION:

The consolidated financial statements include the financial statements of Archroma Pakistan Limited and Archroma Textiles Chemicals Pakistan (Private) Limited. The financial statements of the subsidiary company have been consolidated on line by line basis. All intercompany balances and transactions have been eliminated.

This condensed interim consolidated financial information should be read in conjunction with the annual consolidated financial statements of the company for the year ended 30 September 2015.

### 3. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

3.1 The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this condensed interim consolidated financial information are consistent with those applied in preparation of the published annual consolidated financial information of the Company for the year ended 30 September 2015.

In preparing this condensed interim consolidated financial information, the significant judgements made by management in applying the Company's accounting policies and the key sources of estimation uncertainty were the same as those that applied to the annual consolidated financial statements of the Company for the year ended 30 September 2015

#### 6. SHORT TERM BORROWING - secured

- 6.1 Short term running finance facilities are available from various commercial banks under mark-up arrangements amounting to Rs. 2,400 million (30 september 2015: Rs. 1,800 million). These facilities have various maturity dates upto 31 March 2017. These arrangements are secured against pari passu charge of hypothecation of the Company's stock in trade and trade debts with minimum 16.5% margin. These running finance facilities carry mark-up ranging from 3 months KIBOR + 0.3% to 3 months KIBOR + 0.8% per annum and is payable on quarterly basis.
- 6.2 The Parent Company has borrowed short term running finance under the Export Refinance Scheme of the State Bank of Pakistan of Pakistan (SBP). The facility available is for an amount of Rs. 435 million (2015: Rs. 435 million). The rate of mark-up on this facility was 4.5% per annum.
- 6.3 The Subsidiary Company has obtained the facilities for short term running finances available from a bank amounting to Rs. 600 million (2015: Rs. 600 million). These are secured against hypothecation charge over stock-in-trade and trade debts. The rates of mark-up are 3 months KIBOR +0.35% per annum (2015: 3 months KIBOR +0.35%).

### 10. TAXATION

The Finance Act, 2015 introduced a new tax under Section 5A of the Income Tax ordinance, 2001 at the rate of 10 percent on every public company other than a scheduled bank or modaraba, that derives profits for the tax year and does not distribute cash dividend within six months of the end of said tax year or distribute dividend to such an extend that its reserves, after such distribution, are in excess of 100% of its paid up capital, so much of its reserves as exceed hundred percent of its paid up capital be treated as income of said company. However, this tax on undistributed reserves is not applicable to a public company which distributes profit equal to either 40 percent of its after tax profit or 50% of its paid-up capital, whichever is less, within six months of the end of the tax year.
